



This year 101 Outdoor Arts is celebrating 10 amazing years in Newbury. Since its launch in 2014, 101 has become the principal national centre supporting the creation of arts projects in public space - and we're right down the road at Greenham Business Park!

Inside 101's amazing warehouse, huge rehearsal spaces, wood and metalworking workshops and a residential Artists' Village mean that 300 artists a year can beaver away round the clock to make the spectacular free performances that entertain hundreds of thousands of audiences.

Born out of Corn Exchange's free outdoor arts programme, 101 is now central to producing the incredible international year-round performances that the town hosts - most recently Mo & The Red Ribbon, the giant 6m puppet which paraded through Newbury town centre last September.

101 has also supported artists from across the country to create amazing shows which have been presented in Newbury and around the world including Furious Folly, 451, Dominoes, Future Cargo and last year's CODE. Every year, it hosts hundreds of local people to create the town's muchloved annual Festival of Light lantern procession.
